

PUTTING THIS DREAM TOGETHER

Where do you begin to tell all the wonderful things that Jesus has done? Like so many other folks, I was born and raised in a poor family. My dad died when I was three years old, leaving my mom to raise six boys, just her and Jesus.

We didn't have as many material things as some, but we had a lot of love. At age 14 I had to quit school because of a nerve problem resulting from polio at age 7. I went to work to help out because my other brothers had already married and left home.

I got a job at a truck stop, even though I was extremely afraid of the big trucks. If the Drivers left the trucks running I wouldn't even fuel them. My curiosity finally overcame the fear and I learned to drive a rig on the parking lot of the truck stop. Soon the Drivers learned that I would vacuum, wash windows and check everything on their trucks just for the chance to drive it from the pumps to the parking lot.

I began to drive over the roads as a student Driver at about 18 years old, and at 19 I was drafted into the army. I was married on leave during basic training and was shipped to Vietnam shortly after, where I did a lot of growing up. I soon learned that everybody looks out for himself.

I had already been playing around with drugs and alcohol before I went to 'Nam. After a few months in that hell-hole, I was drinking all the time; "courage", we called it. Three days after I was discharged from the service I was back on the road and back on drugs. One year later, I went to work for a big company with fancy, fast trucks. I was being paid by the mile and it didn't take long to realize that I could run more miles and make more money — all I had to do was take some pills. The money I was making became my god. I thought, "I've really got it made now." But even though I was bringing in good money, there was a void. Something was missing! I became more miserable every day. My life went from bad to worse. I couldn't understand why my wife even stayed with me except for our baby boy.

In 1971 while on a routine run from Dublin, GA to Greenville, SC, I went into an "S" curve and ran off the left side of

the road. My truck turned over and skidded 150 feet on the driver's side. The rig was demolished and the load of carpet went through the roof, front, and side of the trailer. When I realized I had lost control, I was scared out of my mind. I knew if I died where I would go! In 'Nam, bullets had gone right past my head many times, but I had never been so afraid as I was in that wreck.

I had been turning my back on God for many years, and now He had spared my life. Why?

Two weeks later I found myself in a church and at the invitation I went to the pastor. I told him that I needed to change my life and he prayed with me. I poured my heart out to God and that "peace that passes all understanding" (John 14:27, Phil. 4:7) came into my heart and I knew that I was completely set free and forgiven of my sins.

The next day I began to tell the other Truckers what had happened to me. I thought surely everyone would want this wonderful experience! I was surprised when they laughed at me! After all of these years some still laugh, but many have found new life in Jesus through our ministry!

We moved to Atlanta in 1974 and began a deep study of God's Word at a Bible-believing interdenominational church. God used me to win souls as I traveled over half of the U.S. I talked with Truckers like myself about problems we all have to face and told them how Jesus would help solve their problems when they turned them over to Him. I was called to preach while sharing my testimony in a church in Dumas, TX, in 1978 and then licensed to the ministry. In 1980 I was ordained. In 1981 we began holding Truckers' Fellowship Meetings at Truck Stops of America in Atlanta. This was the beginning of what is now Truckstop Ministries, Inc. Many, many Drivers have found new purpose in life by accepting Jesus Christ as their personal Savior, thanks to hundreds of TMI Chaplains across the country. The ministry has grown and God is opening the doors at many locations for our "Truckers' Fellowship Meetings" to be held.

We praise God for all He is doing in our Trucking World! God is "putting this dream together", and working many miracles in the process — and we'll keep "Trucking for Jesus" until the arrival of our soon coming King!
